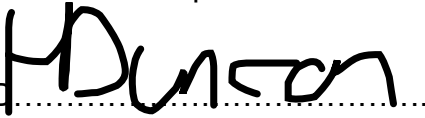

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2019**

This Order is made by Cheshire East Borough Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the public it is expedient that the line of the path described in Paragraph 1 of this Order should be diverted.

Alsager Town Council has been consulted as required by section 120 (2) of the 1980 Act;

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The Public Footpath over the land situated in the Parish of Alsager and shown by a bold continuous black line on the attached plan and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") shall be stopped up on the date on which the Cheshire East Borough Council certifies that the work has been carried out to bring the new highway mentioned in Article 2 into a condition fit for use by the public.
2. There shall be on the date of confirmation a Public Footpath over the land situated in the Parish of Alsager as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached plan.
3. Where immediately before the date on which the Public Footpath referred to in paragraph 1 is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to the statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
4. This Order shall be cited as "The Cheshire East Borough Council (Footpath No. 10 (Part) Parish of Alsager) Public Path Diversion Order 2019."

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of site of existing Path or Way to be diverted

That length of Public Footpath No. 10 in the Parish of Alsager commencing on an un-adopted section of Hall Drive at O.S. grid reference SJ 7917 5502 (point A on Plan No. HA/126A) and running in a generally north easterly direction and following the meanders of the brook for a distance of approximately 187 metres to O.S. grid reference SJ 7928 5513 (point D on Plan No. HA/126A) as indicated by a bold continuous black line between the points marked A-D on Plan No. HA/126A.

A total length of approximately 187 metres.

SCHEDULE

PART 2

Description of site of new Path or Way

A footpath, to be known as, part of Footpath No.10 in the Parish of Alsager commencing on an un-adopted section of Hall Drive at O.S. grid reference SJ 7917 5502 (point A on plan HA/126A) and running in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 18 metres to O.S. grid reference SJ 7918 5503 (point B plan HA/126A), then running in a generally north easterly direction for a distance of approximately 133 metres to O.S. grid reference SJ 7927 5512 (point C HA/126A) and then running in a east north easterly direction for a distance of approximately 44 metres to O.S. grid reference SJ 7928 3551 (point D on Plan No. HA/126A) as indicated by bold black dashes between the points marked A-B-C-D on Plan No. HA/126A.

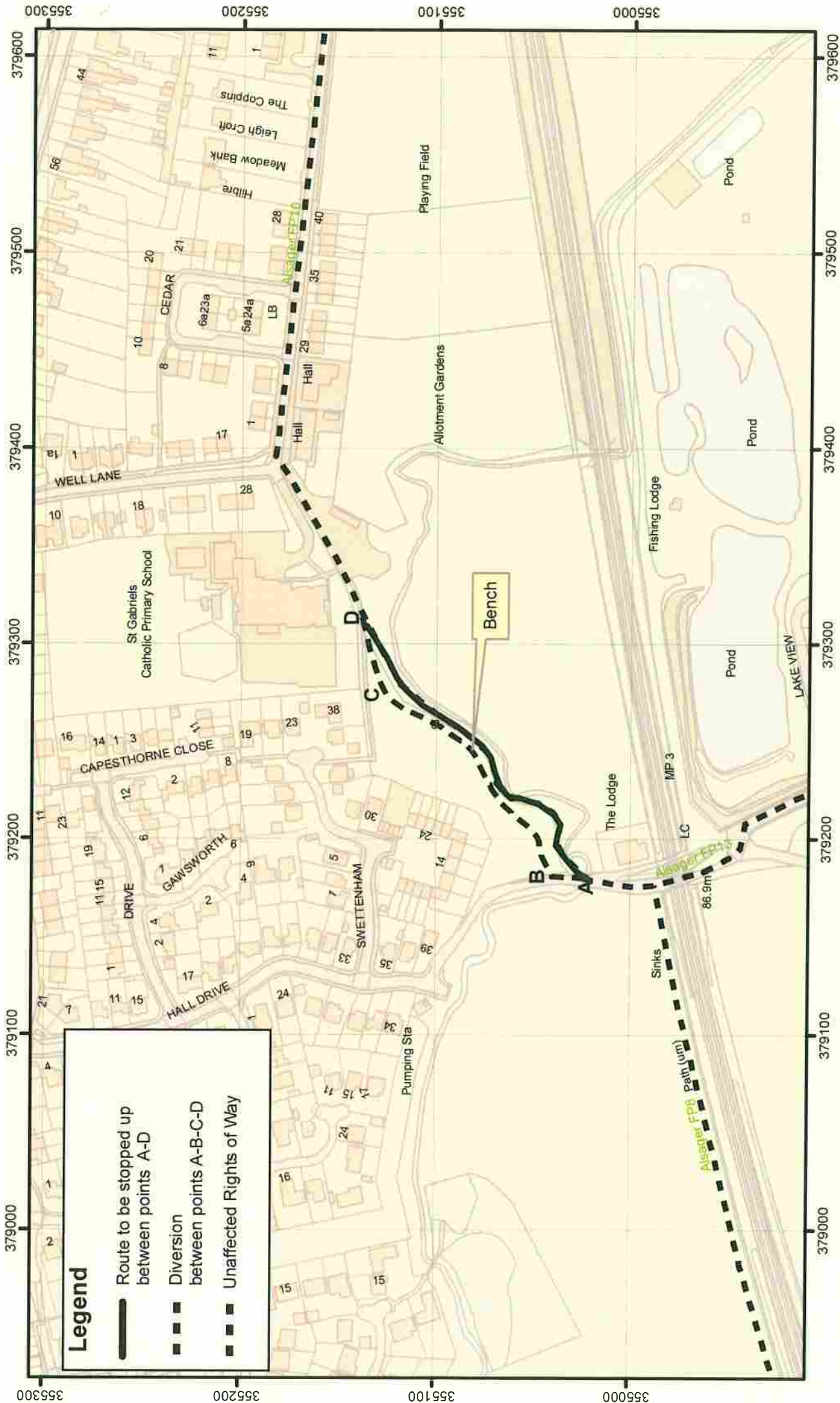
A total length of approximately 195 metres.

The footpath running between points A-B-C-D on Plan No. HA/126A is 2 metres wide with a sealed surface.
