

The King's Coronation – Community Grant

Policy and Terms of Reference

Alsager Town Council has a budget of £1000 for The Kings Coronation, and community groups can apply for funding from this budget up to a maximum of £100 per grant application.

Alsager Town Councils Grants Panel will make the final decision on all grant applications for The King's Coronation Community Grant.

Community groups are encouraged to organise:-

- **A celebratory event, show or party to mark the King Charles Coronation to be held during the weekend of 6 May to 8 May 2023.**
- **An organised activity for The King's Coronation, for example mug painting.**
- **A commemorative fixture such as commemorative benches, plaques, tree planting, flower beds, Town wide floral displays, or temporary street decorations etc. Work on such fixtures must be underway or ordered by 31 May 23.**

The application/use of the grant must be directly related to The King's Coronation and demonstrate appropriate community benefit and/or community input.

The grant may only be used for the purpose for which it was requested.

Applicants are requested to send photos or written information on the event to the Town Council for publicity of the grants awarded.

Funding will not be available for fireworks or to support events at which fireworks are used.

Funding will not be available for any events that involve live animals e.g., donkey rides or prize goldfish.

Timeline and Deadlines

- 13 April 2023 – Deadline for the receipt of application forms.
- 14 April 2023 – Town Clerk and Deputy Town Clerk will meet to consider the applications received.
- Week commencing 17 April 2023 – Applicants will be notified of the decision and payments will be made to nominated bank accounts week commencing 24 April 2023.

Application Process
