



### **Parking Review Statutory Consultation 2023 – You have until 1 November 2023 to “SAY NO”**

Cheshire East Council is seeking views on proposed changes to the borough’s parking arrangements, which aim to improve fairness and consistency across its towns. The statutory consultation opened on 20 September and will run for six weeks until 1 November 2023.
